RESPONSIBILITY

What does the responsible use of GenAI look like?

PRIORITIZE PRIVACY AND SECURITY

GenAI users should exercise caution and limit the amount of personal information shared.



USE ONLY APPROVED TOOLS

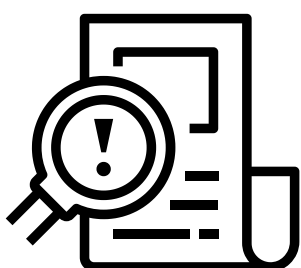
GenAI users should only use approved and age appropriate tools.

Educators looking to use GenAI tools with students should make sure they use only district approved tools and obtain parental consent when needed.



STOP THE SPREAD OF MISINFORMATION

GenAI users should aim to be cautious fact checkers, as not to perpetuate the spread of misinformation. Misinformation is defined as the sharing of false or inaccurate information with no intent to cause harm. It is important that GenAI users verify the accuracy of AI generated content prior to sharing with others.
