
How can we support equity in learning through our use of GenAI tools?

PROMOTE INCLUSIVE ACCESS

GenAl applications have the potential to enhance the educational experience of students, lower barriers to learning, improve student learning outcomes, and support individual student needs.

Our schools should be safe and inclusive spaces where learners can explore and develop their future skills with technology alongside the modelling and support of the classroom teacher.





PRIORITIZE USABILITY

Microsoft Copilot is the recommended district GenAI tool for educators because of its ease of use, integration into our existing district infrastructure, and organizational data security and protection. Even though Microsoft Copilot is secure, users still must be selective and cautious about the data they share, keeping information general and excluding personal information.

Because of the recommended age restrictions of 18+, students are still not recommended to use Chatbots like Microsoft Copilot.
