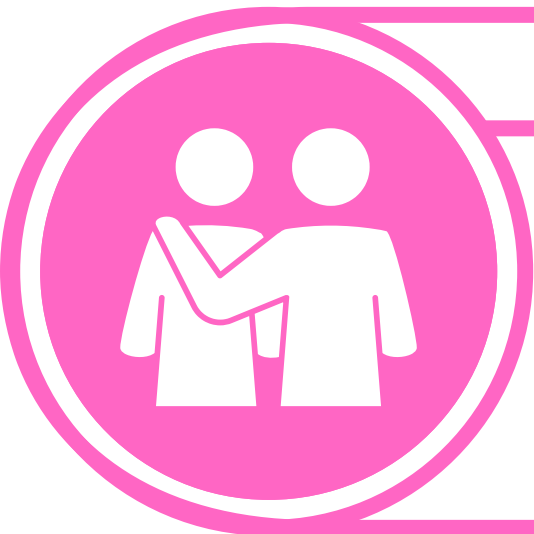
RESPONSIBILITY
